1. MAYOR OR ACTING MAYOR AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS INCLUDING AMENDMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH INSTALLATION OF PHOTOVOLTAIC (PV) SOLAR ARRAY PANELS AT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS LAKE AVENUE LANDFILL AT 685 LAKE AVENUE.

Communication from the Director of Public Works Rogozinski regarding the installation of photovoltaic solar array panels at the Department of Public Works Lake Avenue Landfill.

Corey Lesniak, Director of Operations at CTEC Solar LLC explained that they planned to create an estimated two megawatt photovoltaic solar power plant at the City Landfill.

The Public Works Director stated the panels would be placed on level areas of the Landfill. Much of the City Landfill had steep slopes.

On motion of Council Member Tyler and seconded, it was unanimously voted: To authorize the Mayor or Acting Mayor to execute any and all documents including amendments associated with installation of photovoltaic (PV) solar array panels at the Department of Public Works Lake Avenue Landfill. Said documents shall include but is not limited to the Eversource Year 1 RFP Bid Certification Form and an Option to Lease Agreement with CTEC for a portion of the City's Landfill identified as 685 Lake Avenue (Parcel 04-17).

2. APPROVAL OF CONTRACT WITH TASER INTERNATIONAL NOW KNOWN AS AXON FOR BODY WORN CAMERAS FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZATION FOR MAYOR OR ACTING MAYOR TO EXECUTE CONTRACT.

Communication from the Chief of Police Gould regarding the purchase of body worn cameras due to the police accountability bill.

Mayor Caggiano stated this was a State mandate, but it was an opportunity for the City to save money.

Chief of Police Gould explained that for an administrative vehicle assigned to the police department without a dashboard camera, the operator would have to utilize a body worn camera.

On motion of Council Member Olsen and seconded, it was unanimously voted: To approve a Contract with Taser International now known as Axon for body worn cameras and to authorize the Mayor or Acting Mayor to execute the Contract and any necessary documents.
