Dear Board of Police Commissioners;

In accordance with the Code of Ordinances/Charter Sec. 46A. - Police department—Merit system, which states (in part):

- (11) In lieu of Section 46A(4), 46A(6), 46A(7), 46A(9) and 46B, the following shall apply to testing for non-bargaining positions. All other articles in Section 46A shall apply. Testing for non-bargaining positions shall only be conducted when a vacancy develops or is anticipated by the director of human resources. The director of human resources (or the Mayor's designee in the absence of the director of human resources) shall certify to the chief of police and board of police commissioners an eligibility list consisting of the names of all eligible candidates in order of their total rating who have attained a grade of seventy per cent or higher on both the written and oral examinations based on the following factors and weights.
 - a. Written examination50%
 - b. Oral examination50%
 - Total Rating100%

The chief of police shall then select any one of the top three candidates and forward the selection to the board of police commissioners. The chief of police's selection shall be subject to the approval of and confirmation by the board of police commissioners.

I hereby select Lieutenant Matthew Moskowitz to fill the vacant position of Deputy Chief and therefore request that you appoint Lieutenant Matthew Moskowitz to such vacant position in accordance with section 46A(11).

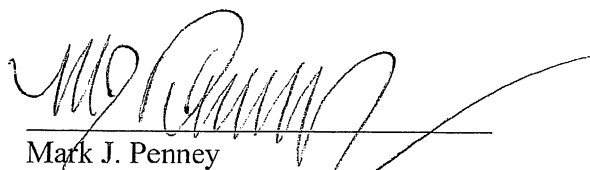

SUBJECT: POLICE DEPUTY CHIEF ELIGIBILITY LIST

Under the provisions of the City Charter, I am submitting to you, a list of the candidates certified as eligible for promotion to the rank of Deputy Chief in the Bristol Police Department in order of their total rating. In accordance with Section 46A(11) of the City Charter which states in part, "The chief of police shall then select any one of the top three candidates and forward his selection to the board of police commissioners. The chief's selection shall be subject to the approval of and confirmation by the board of police commissioners. If the board of police commissioners does not act on the chief's selection within thirty days, said selection shall be deemed to be approved and confirmed. If the board rejects the chief's selection, within thirty days of said rejection, the chief may select from the remaining top two (2) candidates and repeat this process until all of the top three (3) candidates have been exhausted."
