1. Call to Order

Acting Chair Thibeault called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Approval of Minutes

a. Special Meeting June 6, 2024

4. Committee Reports

Council Member Thibeault spoke regarding a past Route 72 Corridor meeting presented by the State DOT in May 2023. She shared the different options they presented to City Council. She stated there will be a meeting August 6th with the Mayor and Raymond Rogozinski with their updated plans. Council Member Thibeault will provide an update to the Committee at the August 27th Meeting.

Council Member Thibeault also discussed the Shrub Rd project, consisting of sidewalks and road diets to make the road narrower with five-foot sidewalks on one side. LT. Krajewski stated that Director Rogozinski had requested a speed limit change which was brought before the Police Commission and it was voted down.

She also discussed briefly the Ridge Road issue as well. Another targeted area if Shrub Rd goes well will be Redstone Hill Rd.

5. New Business

Council Member Thibeault said she would like red light cameras and asked the commission to research it and give their opinion.

City Planner Flanagan mentioned a show called Caught in Providence that is streaming their red-light camera court hearings.

6. Old Business

a. Appointment of Chair

Council Member Thibeault brought to the table the appointment of a Chair. No one agreed at the moment. Commissioner Rooks said he would think about it. Council Member Thibeault stated she would reach out to Ray Peters.

b. Survey

Council Member Thibeault stated that she started creating the survey with the questions discussed at a previous meeting, but the program she was using had a limit to entries. Lt. Krajewski stated that she can use Survey Monkey.

c. City Planner change in ordinance for Transportation Commission

Commissioner Minor stated that it should be brought forward to the Ordinance Committee to change the wording to state that the City Planner or his Designee to attend as a Liaison not a voting member.

d. Bus Shelters

City Planner Flanagan stated that the Bus shelter was brought forward to the DOT and it was approved to add the Bus shelter by Walmart on Route 6.
