Director's Report

In November we saw 3,727 participant swipe ins for programs, 5,812 total members, 7 people deceased, 24 new members, and our fundraiser total for 2024-25 is \$18,955.00.

Our upcoming programs include our Class registration on January 7, A Pasta Dinner Fundraiser on January 9, Our trip registration on January 15, A Harmonica entertainment session on January 22, and all of our winter classes and leagues will start the week of January 27. We are open until 12:00pm on December 24 & 31, and we are closed on December 25, January 1, and January 20.

Our Senior Benefits Coordinator has submitted her report as well. She is currently helping people with energy assistance and helping out with evictions as well.

The speaker project is close to being finished. We only have to program the speakers and they will be on-line. The camera installation is almost complete as well. The shelters are being constructed as we speak. The architects hired by Public Works met with the Health Department on Tuesday for feedback on their drawings and to walk through the spacer a little more. I had a meeting with the Public Works Director to insure that our parking lot renovations are in the plan for next fiscal year and our facility renovations are in the 5 year plan.

We were approved for a temporary emergency position at night for the first three months of the year. I will be putting in for another full time position to work second shift so we can expand our programming and activities. I am currently working on our budget and will have a copy for you to look at next meeting.
