1. Call to Order

Acting Chair Thibault called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Public Participation

Sophie Gochev, 25 Birch Street, addressed the commission requesting speed bumps on Birch Street and crosswalks from Birch to Pine and across Birch connecting Pine. She witnesses excessive speeding on Birch Street daily. She also spoke to the Traffic Division last week.

Lt. Krajewski responded to Ms. Gochev stating that he did review the area and that the sidewalks would need to be redone and made ADA compliant. He stated that the Director of Public works is a hard No to speedbumps. He stated that the speedbumps put in Farmington and Plainville are now being removed due to First Responder slow down and it did not resolve the speeding issue.

Mikki Simons, 58 Wooding Street addressed the commission regarding adding speed bumps to Wooding Street to slow down traffic. Would like something to be done to calm the traffic.

Council Member Thibeault stated that there is a project that will use Shrub Rd to try and calm the traffic by adding barriers in the road and narrowing the road. If it goes well, it will be used on other problem roads.

a. City Council Liaison Report
