The CT Department of Transportation is soliciting applications for Community Connectivity grant funds. The Department of Public Works has used community connectivity grant awards to install and repair sidewalk sections within the City. Previous grant awards to the City have been \$300,000, \$430,000, and \$788,000. Previous funding has focused on the replacement sidewalks and handicap ramps within the City's downtown area.

The Department is requesting the following City Council action to submit a grant application that would fund the replacement of existing asphalt sidewalks with concrete walks on Emmett St (Sycamore St to south of Surrey Dr) along with a new section of concrete sidewalks south of Surrey St on the east side of Emmett St. In total approximately the proposed grant will fund the replacement of 2,699 LF asphalt sidewalk with concrete walks and 488 LF of new concrete walk. In order to submit the application, the Department requests the following City Council action:

**Authorize the Mayor to execute any and all documents associated with the submittal of CT Department of Transportation Community Connectivity Grant application in the amount of \$570,000 to install concrete sidewalk on Emmett St (Sycamore St to Redstone St). The concrete walk will replace 2,699 LF of existing asphalt sidewalk along with the installation of 488 LF of new concrete walk.**

The grant will cover all construction cost. The design will be completed by DPW Engineering.
