5. New Business

a. Resolution to enter into Negotiations with the State of Connecticut on Commuter Parking Lots.

Council Member Thibeault discussed the idea of offering the state a parcel of land of East Main Street so the City could acquire the Todd St Commuter lot.

Motion made by Commissioner Lindsley and seconded by Commissioner Coan to request that the City of Bristol begin negotiations with the State of Connecticut to acquire the property located on Todd Street which is currently used as a commuter lot. This property is noted on the Assessor's files as Account #0241393 further noted as Book and Page 1445/0543. The Transportation Committee also makes the request that city owned property on East Main Street Account# 0099740; Book and Page 1999/0254 be used for parking lot and/or a bus stop to promote Transit Oriented Development (TOD) in Forestville. All in favor, Motion passed.

6. Old Business

Council Member Thibeault shared that Middletown has added the red-light camera's and did do a lot of invoicing in the first two weeks.

Council Member Thibeault shared that the Governor vetoed the bill that affected zoning. That would have affected us as it was giving the state the right to tell zoning how many parking spaces can be associated with a multifamily.
