1. Call to Order

Mayor Caggiano called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. There was a recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Concerns and Petition from the Public

3. Flood and Erosion Previous Meeting Minutes

4. Climate Resilience Study – CT DEEP Grant Update

Raymond Rogozinski, P.E., Director of Public Works, reviewed the resiliency grant and how it will help educate the residents during times of flooding.

Antonio Dicamillo, Stantec, gave an overview of the grant, the project scope and the project schedule including an engagement program for the public.

5. FEMA Insurance Map Update

William Stango, City Engineer, presented the FEMA mapping that is currently in the process of revision. He reviewed the Zone A areas as regulated flood zones that required additional analysis by an engineer to establish the BFE required for a flood plain permit or to establish defined elevations to obtain potentially lower flood insurance rates.

6. Water Quality – MS4 Permit Update

Raymond Rogozinski, P.E., Director of Public Works, spoke about the permit for the Stormwater Permit for Water testing. Public Works is required to address this on a yearly basis.

7. Pequabuck River Water Gauge

Raymond Rogozinski, P.E., Director of Public Works, reviewed the change to the water surface gauging station/flood detection system being done. The cost currently is \$16,800 per year. The new gauge system will cost \$8,470 with an annual cost of \$320/year.
