

BOARD OF SEWER COMMISSIONERS

OCTOBER 18, 2022 – REGULAR MEETING

PRESENT: Chairperson Dunn; Commissioners Phelan, Suarez, Ferrier and Porrini; and Council Liaison Jacqueline Olsen.

1) CALL TO ORDER.

Chairperson Dunn called the meeting of the Board of Sewer Commissioners to order at 6:03 p.m.

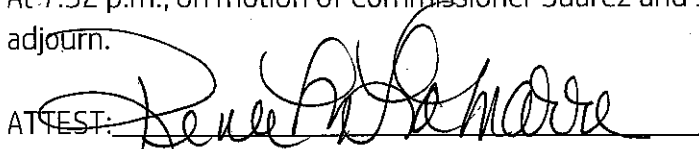
11) NEW BUSINESS.
